

London City Airport Ownership Specifics

NEW YORK, LONDON – In October 2008, Global Infrastructure Partners (GIP) acquired the 50% ownership in London City Airport (LCY) that it did not already own. After giving effect to the sale of a portion of this incremental ownership, GIP now owns a 75% interest in LCY.

No further ownership details have been disclosed.
